We are incredibly excited to talk with you on June 24th regarding the potential CAHA Membership for ACES Hockey Academy. Although we provided CAHA with the necessary information for the application, I thought I would prepare a more detailed packet to allow for a better understanding of our unique program.

**Our Mission Statement:**

Developing character and leadership in student-athletes through academics, service and sport.

**How Our Program Works:**

ACES partners with local schools to provide skill development during team training or as an elective option during the academic day. We currently partner with local schools; Cherry Creek High School, Regis Jesuit High School, Valor Christian High School, and Aspen Academy Middle School. ACES works with all skill levels and kids from all different associations. We have no conflict of interest with any programs; the opposite. Last year we provided skill development for students from all different clubs and associations. Additionally, we sought to place middle school aged beginner skaters into current associations and programs. ACES caters to a group that most other programs do not work with; beginner hockey players aged 10-14, to get them started in hockey.

**Why ACES Chooses to Work with Schools:**

We believe youth athletes should have the opportunity to develop in sport without sacrificing traditional, brick and mortar academics. We believe that all of this can be accomplished through affordable and accessible skill development in a traditional academic setting. Utilizing mid-day ice allows ACES to keep the cost down for families and to provide access to training without adding an additional activity before or after school.

ACES believes that by providing affordable skill development we can grow the sport of hockey. We have seen that our model is successful, particularly at the middle school level.

Aspen Academy Middle School Grades 5-8:

2018-2019 Year:

- 8 skaters total
- 4 advanced
- 4 beginners

Aspen Academy Middle School Grades 5-8:

2019-2020 Year:

- 26 skaters total
- 6 advanced

- 20 beginners (several of these beginner players registered to play with a local program in the spring and are looking for house teams to play with in the fall. Their goal is to play high school hockey in Colorado)

**ACES is not a traditional association or club:**

ACES Hockey Academy is not a traditional association or club and is not seeking to operate as such. We fully support the philosophy of USA Hockey that prior to 14U, youth athletes benefit most from affordable access to the sport, skill development and FUN! We believe this approach lends itself to growth in the sport of hockey. ACES kids do like to play in scrimmages and games, which is why we are interested in the Flex Program, but this is simply to use the skills they have learned in a light hearted and fun environment.

**Why ACES is Applying For CAHA and USA Hockey Membership:**

ACES believes that it is important to work in collaboration with the governing bodies. We believe that rogue programs contribute to the dilution of a market. We believe that we should be held to the same standards, levels of coaching, safe sport rules, and policies that every other youth program is held to. We believe that if we work together as a community we can accomplish far more, than if we work and compete against each other. We also feel like working under the umbrella of CAHA and USA Hockey provides our program with a level of credibility and accountability that we feel benefits our program and families.

**ACES' Future:**

For the upcoming 2020-2021 academic year, ACES will continue to partner with local schools to provide affordable and accessible skill development. However, we are also working hard to open our own school to provide full day, in-person, world-class, private education with high-level hockey and skating skill development in Littleton, CO.

I hope that this provides a bit more detail on the ACES Hockey Academy program, how we operate, and why we are seeking partnership with CAHA and USA Hockey. Please see the attached information for more in-depth details on our coaching staff, our contracted ice hours, and our partnerships.

**BACKGROUND:**

- A. The Client is of the opinion that the Contractor has the necessary qualifications, experience and abilities to provide services to the Client.
- B. The Contractor is agreeable to providing such services to the Client on the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement.

**IN CONSIDERATION OF** the matters described above and of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, the Client and the Contractor (individually the "Party" and collectively the "Parties" to this Agreement) agree as follows:

Services Provided

- 1. The Client hereby agrees to engage the Contractor to provide the Client with services (the "Services") consisting of:

- ICE HOCKEY INSTRUCTION AND TRAINING.

**Ice Contract with Ice Ranch, 841 Southpark Dr. Littleton, CO 80120:** ACES Hockey operates primarily out of the Ice Ranch in Littleton. Please see relevant portions of our ice contract below.



### **Ice Rental Agreement**

This **Ice Rental Agreement** dated June 1, 2020 (the "Agreement"), is made by and between, and entered into by THE ICE RANCH, LLC, a Colorado limited liability company having its principal office at 841 Southpark Dr., Littleton, CO 80120 ("The Ice Ranch" or "Operator"), the owner and operator of an ice arena facility at 841 Southpark Drive, Littleton, CO 80120 (the "Arena"), and Aces Hockey Academy ("Renter"), whose address is: 6158 East Princeton Circle Greenwood Village, CO 80111 for the use of the Arena under the terms set forth below.

1. **Usage:** Games, practices and other specified approved uses.
2. **Use Area:** Ice Surface(s), Locker Room(s), Restaurant and Common Area are included in Ice Rental Rates. Use of Conference and Video Review Room (\$0/hour) are not included in Ice Rental Rates and may be reserved separately, with the foregoing rates being subject to change upon notice to Renter. Operator shall provide, at no additional cost, lighting, ice surfacing, and other miscellaneous services typically provided as a part of the usage described in the Agreement. Operator shall furnish, at no additional cost, the Arena's public address system and scoreboard for use by Renter, and shall assist in training an adequate number of Renter's staff to properly operate such Arena equipment. Operator agrees to keep the rink, locker rooms, showers, and common areas in good condition consistent with, or better than, the standards of comparable ice arenas in the area.
3. **Term:** This Agreement will be for an initial term of three (3) years beginning on August 1, 2020 and ending on July 31, 2025 (the "Initial Term"). There is no auto-renewal of the contract. To extend the contract both parties agree to enter into discussion one year before the contract expires.
4. **Usage Commitment:** Renter hereby commits to pay for all hours used, and to use those hours set forth in Exhibit A hereto (the "Ice Rental Period"). Operator reserves the right to cancel and reschedule certain times allocated to Renter in the Ice Rental Period as set forth herein. No ice contracted may be returned back to the rink unpaid. The Ice Ranch will attempt to sell the ice for the customer with the following conditions:
  - 1) The Renter formally notifies The Ice Ranch via email and confirms with a phone call to the scheduler that the ice will not be used.
  - 2) The amount specified in the Exhibit B is still considered due from the Renter.
  - 3) The Ice Ranch will charge the Renter a fee of 10% of the hourly rate specified in Exhibit B to resell the ice.
  - 4) The Ice Ranch will attempt to sell the ice at the highest price it can attain.

The net result due will then be the hourly rate plus the 10% fee if the ice is resold, minus the amount collected for the sold ice.
